

## **PROPERLY FILLED IN SCORE CARD MUST HAVE:**

**(Items 1 - 4 must be filled out at the registration desk)**

1. Your name must be filled in COMPLETELY; your address is not necessary.
2. Your style of shooting – (FS, BHFS, FSL, BB, etc.).  
NOTE: BH is not a style of shooting. Must be BHFS, BHFSL, etc.  
Class – AA, A or B. This must be marked on your scorecard before you start shooting.
3. The scorecard should be marked for Male or Female shooter.
4. If you are a Junior Archer under age 18 – put your age on your scorecard.  
(Junior archers are eligible in only certain styles. Cub 11 and under, Youth 12 – 14, Young Adult 15 - 17

**(Items 5 - 12 can be filled out by the archer)**

5. The Club you belong to must be filled in (Do NOT use abbreviations such as ROA, OCSC etc.).
6. The Regional Association you belong to must be filled in (this can be abbreviated, CMAA, MET, SVAA etc.).
7. INDOOR NFAA ROUND - ALL SCORING BOXES (ARROW AND SPOTS) MUST BE FILLED IN. SCORE OF “5” WITH A SPOT INDICATED BY AN “X”. ALL OTHERS MUST HAVE A NUMBER, INCLUDING A “0” FOR A MISS.
8. FOR THE “FITA” AND THE “TARGET 900” SCORE A MISS WITH THE LETTER “M”. KEEP TRACK OF THE SMALL INNER "X" AS WELL.
9. Scores must be totaled and the total shown on top or bottom of the card.
10. All signatures must be filled in – scorer, scorer, archer (Due to the archer being a scorer, his/her signature may appear twice)
11. Disqualifying an archer after a shoot is over is not an enjoyable experience but in fairness to all archers, must be done if the scorecard is not properly filled out. THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SCORE CARD BELONGS TO YOU, THE ARCHER. If you have any questions, ask before turning in your scorecard. Once the scorecard is turned in, it is too late.
12. PARENTS – you are responsible for your children’s scorecards. CHECK THEM OVER BEFORE THEY ARE TURNED IN.
